2019 HIGHLIGHTS IN HEALTH AND EDUCATION AT PROJECT SALUD Y PAZ

Project Salud y Paz serves the indigenous Maya people through 3 permanent clinics located in Camanchaj, Nahuala, and Cunen as well as our school, Colegio Susanna Wesley (CSW).

- In the western highlands, our Guatemalan doctors, dentist, nurses and staff at Salud y Paz clinics saw **3,829 dental patients and 4,389 medical patients**
- 3,019 laboratory tests were performed in Salud y Paz clinics
- **184 diabetic patients** were provided follow up, education, labs and medicines in our chronic illness management program
- 285 patients were provided referrals assistance through our social work program
- 12 volunteer medical/dental/optical teams treated **5,670 patients in 34 communities** surrounding Chichicastenango, Nahuala, Cunen and Quetzaltenango.
- Thanks to surgeons and support staff from Pulaski Heights United Methodist Church,
 Little Rock, Arkansas we provided life-changing cataract surgery for 25
 patients and general surgery for 57 patients
- Construction teams completed Victor Ajanel's home, worked alongside a congregation building a church and made progress at the new Salud y Paz clinic building
- Lawrence First Church installed **70 water filters in the homes of families from Chichicastenago**, in a pilot program coordinated with partner organization All In

 Guatemala
- At Colegio Susanna Wesley, 45 children ages 4-7 enjoyed hands-on learning with plants, animals, and art while 14 of those young students became proficient readers
- And finally, more than 148 different individuals, families, foundations,
 universities, and churches gave monetary donations to carry out the mission of "providing health, healing, and education with the people of Guatemala"


